



Underage Policy

Standard Liquor Licence Rules for All Venues:

A minor can remain on licensed premises if they are:

- in the company of a responsible adult; or
- on the premises for the purpose of having a meal; or
- a resident of the premises; or
- engaged in a training program or work experience.

Definition of a Responsible Adult:

A person who is over 18 years of age and who is:

- the younger person's parent, step-parent, guardian or grandparent; or
- the younger person's spouse; or
- a person who is acting in place of a parent and who could reasonably be expected to exercise responsible supervision of the younger person.

Special Condition on Rack-em-up's Liquor Licence:

"The Licensee has the approval of the Director of Liquor Licensing to allow the presence of underage persons on the licensed premises in connection with sporting activities only. This approval does not include social activities (but does include attendance at a presentation function)."

Rack-em-up's Stance on Underage Patrons:

In general, Rack-em-up is known for being family friendly venue which welcomes parents & their children who wish to play pool together as a family. Rack-em-up is also very proud of our Junior Program where many of our Juniors have participated in the State, National & World 8-Ball competitions.

Rack-em-up does not allow any underage patrons with a Blood Alcohol Concentration above 0.00.

REU Policy on Underage Patrons:

- No Underage patrons on a Friday or Saturday Night after 8pm.
- Underages are allowed at all other times if they have a Blood Alcohol Concentration of 0.00 and are
 - in the company of a responsible adult, or
 - participating in the Junior Training program, or
 - participating in the In-House Pool Leagues, or
 - here to practice playing pool & not here for social reasons.
- If an Underage person is found to be drinking alcohol whilst either inside or outside Rack-em-up, then both that underage patron and all of the group that is here with them will be asked to leave.
